

## **NSCA FOUNDATION (NSCAF) SCHOLARSHIP REVIEW COMMITTEE**

### **Scholarship Review Committee Purpose**

To review applications for scholarships supported by the NSCAF and make recommendations for funding.

### **Membership**

The Scholarship Review Committee will be composed of five (5) individuals including one (1) representative from the NSCAF Board of Directors (BOD). The remaining four (4) committee members will be recruited from the general NSCA membership by the current sitting members of the review committee. Members should embody at least one characteristic of the five major scholarship categories (High School, Minority, Power Systems® Professional, Challenge or Women's). The NSCAF BOD approves members from qualified applicants as submitted by the review committee Chair. Committee members must be current NSCA members and will serve a three year term with members rotating off annually. Members may be reappointed to the committee and serve consecutive three year terms, but can only serve two full terms in their lifetime. Service of less than half the term is not a full term.

The Scholarship Review Committee shall elect a Committee Chair from among their membership who is responsible for:

- Implementing the committee purpose statement as approved by the NSCAF BOD
- Scheduling meetings as necessary via conference call or email; if necessary, a meeting of the committee can be held in conjunction with the NSCA National Conference
- Communicating with the NSCAF Board Liaison and the NSCA Headquarters Staff Liaison
- Distributing scholarship applications for review to other members of the committee, tallying results, and making recommendations to the NSCAF BOD for funding

The NSCAF BOD liaison may not serve as the Chair of the Scholarship Review Committee
